



Sunday, September 11, 2011 • Villars

Today is a free day with several options available. Perhaps some would like to hike on the beautiful Swiss trails, some may want to visit one of the nearby vineyards along Lake Geneva, or perhaps some may want to visit nearby L'Abri fellowship founded by Francis Schaefer or the Reformation Monument in Geneva. Monday, September 12, 2011 • Villars



After breakfast this morning we head for **Montreux**, a lovely resort town along Lake Geneva, where we have the morning to explore. After lunch at a nearby vineyard, we visit the 12th century **Chateau de Chillon**—made famous by the romantic poet Lord Byron. **B/L**

Tuesday, September 13, 2011 • Zermatt

Today is another day of spectacular scenery as we head for Zermatt in southern Switzerland. At Visp we board the **Cogwheel Railway** and ascend to **Zermatt** at the base of the Matterhorns. Here we enjoy free time to explore the village of cobbled pedestrian streets dating from the Middle Ages or perhaps take a late afternoon hike into the mountains. **B/D**

Wednesday, September 14, 2011 • Lugano/Gandria

We descend by train to Täsch this morning and re-board our coach. We travel through the picturesque **Matterhorn Valley** and then drive the scenic **Simplon Road** over the **Simplon Pass** into Italy. We stop in **Domodossola**, a little Italian

hill town with a charming market place and notable collegiate church with frescoes from the 15th century. Then we continue along the shore of Lake Maggiore and through Locarno stopping in **Bellinzona** to see **Castello di Sasso Corbaro**. After some free time we continue to Gandria, Switzerland, a colorful fishing village a few kilometers east of Lugano. The remainder of the day is spent exploring some of Gigi's favorite places in the village. **B/D**

Thursday, September 15, 2011 • St. Moritz Area

Every day the scenery is amazing!! Today we follow the trail sometimes referred to as the **Palm Express**. We re-enter Italy and stop in **Menaggio** on the shores of Lago di Como (Lake Como). We pass along **Lake Como** with its beautiful blue waters, sparsely forested hills, and rustic lakeside towns. We make a quick stop in the small town of **Chiavenna** and then cross the Swiss border at the northern edge of Lake Como. We stop in the village of Soglio for lunch. Continuing on we cross the Inns River and small lakes appear as we approach St. Moritz. Tonight we stay in St. Moritz. **B/L**

CURRENCY:

Currency exchange rates fluctuate constantly. In the event of a significant drop in the value of the dollar, we reserve the right to add a currency surcharge to the price of the tour.

REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY:

All cancellations must be in writing. The date of postmark will determine the amount of refund due. Refunds are based on the number of days prior to departure date. From the time of deposit to 100 days before departure a \$100 administrative fee will be assessed. From 99-14 days, a \$300 cancellation penalty plus any unrecoverable deposits will be assessed. Anyone cancelling less than 14 days prior to departure will receive no refund. Airline tickets (if applicable) once written are usually not refundable.


We offer optional insurance for cancellation, life, health, and baggage. We strongly recommend purchase of this insurance.


